General Notes: Hazel Stimson, in her writings, said that Milton and Eliza Stimson had two children that died as infants. She had the names Alba and Susie. I have found no documentation on these children.

In the 1900 census Eliza indicated the she had given birth to 8 children and that 5 were still living. Della had died by the time of that census. The five living children would have been, William, Maggie, Calvin, Edward, and Harry. That leaves the possibility that the two unaccounted for were Alba and Susie. The dates given here for Alba were taken from Tribal Pages, Stimson Hickman family. Based on the time span between the births of the other children, the most likely time for Susie's birth would have been between Calvin and Edward.

Dear Harry,

I still have some work to do on the Cross family, but here is what I have so far.

Our connection to the Cross family is through our Grandmother Mary Emma Cross Stimson, the youngest child of Hiram Cross, who was the youngest child of Ebenezer Cross. In Mother's paper Who Am I she wrote, "After the Civil War, Hiram Cross moved his family from Kentucky to settle on a homestead in Kansas, around Salina and Hutchinson." This memory does not seem to be accurate. In my research, I found no link of the Cross family to Kentucky.

Ebenezer Cross, Hiram's father, was a farmer living at least the later part of his life in Hanover, Chautauqua County, New York. The information I have about Ebenezer primarily comes from a will he left when he died in 1838. He was married twice and the information about his wives is sketchy. In his information I have the name of his first wife as Abigail, but I don't know where I found that. His second wife was Elizabeth French, a native of England. He did not give the name of either wife in his will, but he named five children with his first wife and six with his second. Hiram was the youngest of the 11.

At the time of Ebenezer's death, the children from his first marriage would have ranged from 39 to 49 years old. I Have not been able to trace all of them but I think they all established households in New York state. The children from the second marriage ranged in age from 28 to 19. All six of them and their mother Elizabeth eventually moved west and settled in Stephenson County, Illinois. I have not yet established the timing or order of the children's moves, but I eventually may figure it out from census information. As of the 1850 census, they were all in Stephenson County.

Hiram, age 30, married Clarrisa J. Bennett, age 16, in New York September 16, 1849. The 1850 census for Waddams Township, Stephenson County, Illinois, is dated October 3,1850. The 1850 census is the first census that lists all household members by name and age. Hiram is listed as head of household with 17 year old Clarissa, 40 year old brother Aaron, 38 year old sister Clarissa, 3/12 year old Ellen, and 64 year old mother Elizabeth. The census shows that all were born in New York with the exception of Ellen who was born in Illinois. That would place Hiram's move between Sept. 16, 1849 and July, 7, 1850. Hiram was listed as a miller and Aaron a carpenter. In the 1860 census Hiram was listed as a laborer and then in 1870 as a farmer.

Hiram moved his family to Kansas between the 1870 census and the birth of our Grandmother Mary Emma in 1877. The 1880 census places the family in Hayes, Mitchell County, Kansas Hiram was listed as a farmer and Corwin was a laborer. Most of the 1890 census was destroyed but a small obituary said that Hiram died in Wilson, Ellsworth, Kansas, on Feb 2, 1894, of poor health and old age.

Although Hiram appears to have moved directly from Illinois to Kansas, it turns out that there was a considerable presence of the Cross family in Iowa at the time. Hiram's older brother,

Daniel Frederick Cross, had five children settle in Iowa. (1) Parcy Elizabeth Cross Malaney's 6th child was born in Humeston, Wayne county, Iowa, 27 Feb 1882. Parcy's husband, Michael died 13 Dec 1913, in Humeston, and Parcy died 6 Mar 1922 in Centerville, Iowa. (2) Mary Jane Cross McIntosh's last three children were born in Story County, Iowa. The family had to have been there as early as 1874. (3) Levi and his son Edgar M. Cross were in Manchester at the time of the 1900 census. Edgar M. Cross's family ended up in Marshalltown. (4) Daniel Elbert Cross married Sarah Shepley in Story County, Iowa in 1879. They and three of their children are buried in Nevada, Iowa or Des Moines. (5) Hiram William Cross was in Manchester as of the 1900 Census. His first wife died in 1891 and is buried in the Oakland Cemetery, so he must have been in the area at least that early. He had three sons all of whom died in Iowa, Lester as late as 1971. Hiram William Cross had married a second time by the time of the 1900 census. That second wife was Mary Hannah Ferguson. The marriage ended in divorce and Mary Ferguson in 1910 married Roy Downs. Mother said "one of Mary Cross' close friends were Roy and Mate Downs."

Another cousin of Grandmother's was Ira Hulbert who was a farmer in Delaware township as of the 1880 census. He eventually died in Nebraska in 1892. Two of his children were married in Masonville. Irwin E Hulbert married Alma Josephene Gardner 3 Oct 1884 and Roralie L. Hulbert married Frank Orvis 3 Oct 1886.


Also in Masonville was Viola Cross, Grandmother's sister. Viola Cross was listed in the 1915 lowa census living in Masonville. In that census she indicated that she had been in lowa for 25 years. That would place her in lowa about 1890. According to Mother, "Ola also came to Masonville where she worked at the local switchboard for many years. Later she lived with Harry and Mary for some years but returned to Kansas before her death."

Again, according to Mother, "I seem to remember that Mother Stimson told me that she was the youngest of nine sisters and two brothers and Roy agrees with me that he remembers it this way but we are unable to name this many so we may be mistaken." In my research, I have been able to find only seven girls and two boys. At the time of the 1900 census, Grandmother Mary's mother, Clarissa Cross, was living with Harry and Mary. In the census she is listed as having been the mother 13, with 11 still living. In the 1910 Census she was living with Corwin Cross and she was listed as the mother of 12 children with 9 still living. Perhaps we will find obituaries that will help solve this matter.

In Mother's notes, she said that Grandfather Harry met Mary Cross when she came to visit her brother Corwin who was running a creamery in Masonville. Corwin was in Kansas for the 1880 census and I do not know precisely when he moved to lowa, but he married Alta Louisa Britton in Masonville on October 28,1883. She was the daughter of B. B. Britton, a farmer in Prairie Township. Corwin, in the marriage record, is listed as a farmer. In an 1885 lowa State census he is listed as a laborer, but residing on 40 acres in Coffins Grove Township. An 1894 land ownership map shows Corwin on 40 acres in Coffins Grove just outside of Masonville. His home location is important to us because Grandfather Harry S. Stimson and Mary Emma Cross were


married March 2, 1898 at the residence of Corwin Cross. Witnesses were Calvin Stimson and Nola Cross.

Corwin was in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, for the 1900 census. In that census he listed 'creamery worker' as his occupation. In the 1910 census Corwin was in Enid, Oklahoma, working at a flour mill. He died in Enid Aug. 3, 1914. I have not found out where he or his wife are buried.
